Dear Parent/Guardians:
Buffalo Trail Public Schools Inclusive Learning Department and the Transportation Department are in the process of determining transportation needs for the school year for your child. To qualify for this funding the following criteria must be met:
 As a child with diverse learning and or physical needs, your child has been approved to attend a PUF/Inclusive Learning Program with Buffalo Trail Public Schools and; Your child's home (resident address) is 1.0 kilometers for grade K-6 students or 2.0 kilometers for grades 7-12 students or greater from the school they have been directed to attend for his/her program if riding a yellow bus and/or; The severity of the disability prevents them from riding a regular school bus (Please refer to 701.22AP, Designated Means of Student Transportation: Parent/Agent Provided).
All individual circumstances will be considered and reviewed by the Inclusive Learning Department, School Principal and/or designate, and the Director of Transportation.
In order to be eligible for transportation services, the included registration form (701.23AP Exhibit 2) must be completed and returned to your child's inclusive learning teacher. The registration form must be completed in its entirety for transportation services to be determined and incomplete registration forms will be returned.
Please be advised that you must provide a physical street address for funding to be determined. Rural residents must provide a legal land location as opposed to a street address. Post office boxes cannot be considered as a physical address.
