Pre-Alert Letter

Dear Parents/Guardians,

It has come to my attention that a student from Mannville School has tested positive for COVID-19. Every case of COVID-19 is investigated by Alberta Health Services (AHS), and we are working with them to provide up to date information/communication. We are unable to share specific information as we protect the individual's confidentiality and follow AHS privacy guidelines.

This person has not been in our building since December 3, 2020, and had very limited contact with staff and students while at the school. AHS and information from the family, indicated that since the onset of symptoms did not appear until Friday, December 4, 2020, it is unlikely that this was contracted or spread within our school. If AHS determine that a case of COVID-19 is confirmed to have been infectious or acquired disease in a school setting, a letter from AHS will be sent out to all parents/guardians. If AHS determine that this person did not acquire disease in school, or attend school while they may have been infectious, a letter will not be sent.

Those who were in close contact with the student, will be contacted via phone and email from the school administration. If you do not receive a phone call or email by noon today, please continue to follow all COVID-19 guidelines and protocols as usual.

AHS is currently conducting a case investigation to determine if there was contact with individuals outside of school last week. If one of our school community members is deemed a close contact of this case (with contact occurring outside of the school), they will be receiving a follow up call from Alberta Health Services. The Alberta Government, AHS and our school administration are collectively committed to being as transparent as possible in respect to COVID-19 cases.
