As a result of there being two or more cases of COVID-19 confirmed within Mannville School, AHS has declared Mannville School as a COVID-19 outbreak school. AHS are investigating and will continue to work with us through this process. As of this morning, all school-based COVID-19 known, close contacts, have been contacted by school administration.

**Beginning Monday, December 14, 2020, our elementary grades (Kindergarten-Grade 6) will move to at home learning.** Our staff are diligently working to prepare/gather materials for next week as well as the week of January 4-10, 2021. Some of this may come home today as paper-based materials, or staff may contact parents/students through email, and provide online resources and instructions, prior to Monday.

Staff will connect with students online each day throughout the week, and a schedule is attached for the times you can expect to be online with each staff member. Staff is hoping to continue some of our countdown events next week during your google meets, as they too will be missing out on all the fun learning and events that were planned!
