Pre-Alert Letter

Dear Parents/Guardians of WHS Grade 12C Students,

It has come to our attention that a person affiliated with the Grade 12C classes has tested positive for COVID-19. This person was last in school on April 23, 2021. Our Superintendent will be in contact with AHS as we work through this process together. AHS has indicated that confirmation of the dates for any close contacts will not be available for at least 48 hours. We know from a previous positive case that it may take up to 5 days.

As a precautionary measure, until we get confirmation from AHS, our Grade 12C students will move to at home learning on Friday, April 30 and Monday, May 3. All Grade 12C students will receive follow-up communication on Monday, May 3rd. By being cautious in our approach, we feel we are minimizing the spread of COVID-19 as well as ensuring that our students and staff remain safe.

As a reminder, please continue to be diligent to fill out the daily checklist which is found [here](#). If your child has any of the symptoms of illness listed on the Alberta Health daily checklist call Health Link at 811 and keep your child at home if they show symptoms. Thank you for your efforts in this, as they really do make a difference!

This is a reminder that we need to continue to be diligent in following the guidelines during outbreaks as this does impact the learning in school. Thank you for your continued diligence as we know that the restrictions and guidelines are tiring.
