<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Supports available for student mental health. ✓ Accommodations for students with pre-existing medical conditions are available. ✓ Student support services will continue following enhanced guidelines. ✓ All staff and students entering the school will complete AHS Daily Screen Checklist or the visitors will complete the BTPS COVID-19 APP. ✓ Any student ill at school will be isolated and picked up within an hour. ✓ BTPS will work in conjunction with Alberta Health Services and Alberta Education if COVID-19 is identified within our schools 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ As much as possible classes and all courses will continue following specific guidelines. ✓ Before entering and exiting the class, proper hand hygiene must be followed. ✓ Some learning opportunities may be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Outside, virtual, theory (over practical) ✓ No fall performances of music, dance, theatre. ✓ Alternate learning options for students are available through Students Online School. ✓ Sports follow ASAA and Alberta Education guidelines. ✓ PATs and DIPs will be completed in June, 2021. ✓ No field trips for fall 2020 which require a bus. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Staggered start for beginning the school year. ✓ Proper hand hygiene will be followed. ✓ Materials organized per student where possible. ✓ High touch areas cleaned throughout day. ✓ Soft furnishings and rugs removed from classroom. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ All students must complete the AHS Daily Screen Checklist at home. ✓ Grades 4-12 students and all staff will wear masks when: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> On bus, entering school, in common areas and when physical distancing is not possible. ✓ Students to bring a full water bottle. ✓ Classes and buses will have seating plans. ✓ Teachers will move to students where possible. ✓ Minimal number of adults with a group of students. ✓ Signs and direction arrows may direct flow of traffic. ✓ Recess and lunches may be staggered. ✓ Daily drop off and pick up designated. ✓ Microwaves and vending machines removed for September. ✓ No sharing of food or utensils. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Provincially recommended sanitizer and cleaning supplies. ✓ Hand sanitizer at entry of school and in classrooms. ✓ Custodian available throughout day for high touch area cleaning. ✓ Proper hand hygiene required before entering and exiting school, classrooms, any equipment is shared and before eating. ✓ Shared equipment regularly cleaned. ✓ No non-essential items allowed at school (ie toys). ✓ Strict illness procedures established in schools. ✓ Soft furnishings and rugs removed from classroom. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Visitor access will be limited until further notice. ✓ All visitors must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use front entrance. Wear a mask. Complete the BTPS COVID-19 APP.
