Pre-Alert Letter for Bus WW-23S

Dear Parents/Guardians,

It has come to our attention that a person affiliated with bus WW-23S has tested positive for COVID-19. Anyone within 3 rows will be contacted and asked to isolate as per AHS regulations. All potential close contacts will receive follow-up communication, this process is underway right now. The principal sent the bus home this morning as a precautionary measure as they did not know at the time who the close contacts would be. Students who are not close contacts associated with the bus or the school can continue to ride. The bus will be operating.

As a reminder, please continue to be diligent to fill out the daily checklist which is found [here](#). If your child has any of the symptoms of illness listed on the Alberta Health daily checklist call Health Link at 811 and keep your child at home if they show symptoms. Thank you for your efforts in this, as they really do make a difference!

This is a reminder that we need to continue to be diligent in following the guidelines during outbreaks as this does impact the learning in school. Thank you for your diligence.
