The Board of Trustees believes that all students should have the right to a safe and caring learning environment. Therefore, the Board forbids the practice known as "hazing", that is, the subjection of students to various forms of punishments or indignities.

## **GENERAL PROCEDURES:**

- 1. The subjection of students to hazing is forbidden, whether:
  - 1.1 On the school premises,
  - 1.2 In connection with school activities on or off the school premises,
  - 1.3 To and from school.
- 2 For introducing new students to a school, "welcome activities" rather than "frosh" activities are encouraged.
- 3. In determining what constitutes hazing and welcome activities, the decision of the school administration shall be final.
- 4. Any student participating in hazing will be disciplined according to school and division policy.
