

302.5AP Out-of-Division Program Placement Agreements

PROCEDURES:

- 1. The following criteria will be taken into consideration when determining whether an out-ofdivision program placement is warranted.
 - 1.1 The appropriate educational program cannot be provided by the Division.
 - 1.2 The student qualifies as a funded student under Alberta Education guidelines as of September 30th of the school year.
 - 1.3 The parents are supportive of the out-of-division program placement
 - 1.4 The school is supportive of the out-of-division program placement.
 - 1.5 A recent individual psycho-educational, behavioral and/or achievement assessment, completed by a mutually agreed upon third party assessor, supports the need for the out-of-division program placement.
- 2. The agreement with another school authority will be based on the following criteria:
 - 2.1 If the out-of-division program placement is significantly different from the program offered by the Division, the support provided will be limited to the extent of the grant portions of the funding available.
 - 2.2 Continued support will be based on the student's success in the out-of-division program placement (i.e., academic, attitude, effort, attendance, etc.), the continued need for the program, and the Division's inability to provide such a program in-house.
 - 2.3 The Board may agree to access transportation and room and board funding for the student to the maximum provided by Alberta Education.

- 3. Regardless of the source of the request for out-of-division program placement, the first contact must be made with the Superintendent.
- 4. The Superintendent or designate, in consultation with the Director of Inclusive Learning, will within ten school days, determine whether or not to support the request.
- 5. The recommendation for out-of-division program placement will be presented to the Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
- 6. The decision of the Board shall be communicated in writing to the parents by the Superintendent within ten school days of the Board's decision.
- 7. If the request for out-of-division placement is not agreed to, the parents will be informed of their right to appeal the decision and the process to be followed.
