- To receive 602.2AP, 2nd Parcel Out Funds Disbursements for School Projects, as amended, for information
- To approve the request from EH Walter School for \$6000.00 cash in lieu funds to go toward the purchase of 20 new Chromebooks and a Chromebook cart
- To appoint Pam Peterson as the substitute returning officer for the 2021 school board election

OTHER NEWS

- The Board was pleased to host students from Irma, KHS and Marwayne schools for its Student Engagement session. This month the topic discussed was Personal Growth and Wellbeing.
