PAYRIDE BUSSING SERVICE:

1. Provincial grant claim forms will be prepared annually by Student Transportation Services and approved by the Secretary Treasurer using the September 30th student count. Claim form information will be compiled and forwarded to Alberta Education in accordance with the School Funding Manual.
