





Any vehicle with a registered **Gross Vehicle Weight of 4500Kgs** or more and if any of the vehicles in the fleet operates in more than one province is designated a **COMMERCIAL** VEHICLE.

What vehicles are exempt from the Commercial Vehicle regulations?

Privately owned vehicles, recreational vehicles such as motor homes, and farm equipment

You are required to keep your logs for a period of 6 months-unless there is an incident, then that log must be kept for a period of 5 years.

How often must you submit your driver's logs to the carrier?

- 7. Functional Assessment tests
- 8. Proof of Professional Development
- 9. Driver Certification
