News from the Board: August 2023

Communication Strategy:

At the August meeting the following motions were passed;

- To engage with Central leadership in a fall engagement session to be held on September 26th
- To support Trustees Cooper, Ford and Spornitz for the Wainwright Elementary School Design Ad Hoc Committee.
- To rename board policy Section 9 from Alcohol, Tobacco, Inhalant and Cannabis to General and move BP401, Welcoming, Caring, Respectful and Safe Workplace & Learning Environments renumbered to BP901.
- To engage the consultant and continue with the final phase of the ward review.
- To direct administration to work with the Hardisty parent group and bus contractor to seek a solution for Irma student bussing similar to the past school year.

 To recognize Military Family Appreciation Day on the third Friday in September and request administration to communicate the Board's support.



OTHER NEWS

- The Board welcomed new Superintendent Webb to her first official board meeting, along with new Assistant Superintendent of HR, Camille Quinton and new Secretary Treasurer, Peter Neale.
- The Board also passed a motion to receive new administrative procedure 500.2AP, Volunteers for information. You can check the link <u>here</u>. The Board also accepted the amendments to transportation administrative procedures that recognize the changes in bussing criteria from less than 2.4 km to now read 1.0 km for grades K to 6 or 2 km for grades 7 to 12. Work on Board policies and administrative procedures is always ongoing.
