#### The Board

The Board was pleased to receive a letter from the Alberta Government as a follow-up to the construction funding approval for the Wainwright Elementary School replacement project is also eligible for up to \$250,000.00 in playground funding. The Town of Wainwright has authorized the transfer of land to the Buffalo Trail School Division for the new Wainwright Elementary School site. Several Trustees will attend the upcoming Alberta Rural Education Symposium March 2-4, 2025 and bring an update back to its next Board meeting. This year's theme is "Ensuring Equitable Outcomes for Rural Students'. The Board is continuing to review all BTPS policies for this school year.

# Student Engagement

The Board welcomed students from The BTPS Learning Hub to the student engagement. The theme for this month's engagement was Alternative Learning. The students were invited to share their thoughts on the questions 1) Can you share why the Learning Hub is a supportive environment for you? 2) If you were to explain to other students how the Learning Hub is a great place to learn, What would you say? There was a common theme to the students' responses. The students shared how the Learning Hub is a comfortable environment to work and learn at your own pace and get support as you need it.

## Superintendent's Department

The Superintendent shared highlights from the Leadership Team that included an update on Bill 27 implementation, the BTPS Learning Day and the 2024-2025 Alberta Education Assurance survey. Celebrations included a new BTPS Flourishing story submitted to the Rural Caucus of Alberta School Boards (RCASB) showcasing the Math Diploma Review Program and the Pathways to Career Success Grant. The ASBA Edwin Parr Award recognizes excellence in teaching for first year K-12 teachers. Division staff are eligible to nominate first year teachers. Nominations can be sent in to the Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources and a division winner will be selected from by the Board's committee to go to the ASBA Award evening.
